As part of the 2022 Windham Master Plan update, the Windham Local Energy Committee (LEC) will be writing the Energy Chapter and would like to hear what areas you think we should be focusing on, what you think is important, and what your thoughts are regarding how our town can best respond to higher energy prices and the changing energy landscape.

This Special Local Energy Committee Meeting will be seeking your energy-related ideas. We strongly encourage your attendance and participation since the Town's Master Plan should reflect the Town's objectives and needs. Please help us move toward this goal.

The LEC would like to hear your thoughts/ideas on:

- The Town's adoption of an Electrical Aggregation plan to negotiate the best kwh pricing for the town residents in response to recent electric rate increases;
- Electrification of home heating/cooling with new heat pump technologies;
- Adoption of renewable energy sources for municipal, residential and commercial buildings;
- Implementation of energy-related measures of the Inflation Reduction Act;
- The Town's support of residential and commercial building energy efficiency upgrades;
- Community interest in Town's providing educational programs for energy efficiency; and
- Examples of energy generation/conservation measures adopted by other communities.

In addition, the LEC is hoping you can expand this list with your ideas and experiences. We look forward to your participation in this Special LEC Meeting to help shape Windham's energy future.
