SIGNAGE REQUEST – ROULSTON ROAD NEAR RAIL TRAIL

Dennis Senibaldi reported that the conditions of the shoulders of Roulston Road near the Rail Trail were being significantly degraded by cars parked along the side of the road. He his requesting No Parking signs be posted along that section of Roulston Road. Chief Caron noted that parking is available near the Rail Trail on Route 28 in Salem.

Bob Coole made a motion to draft a letter to the Board of Selectmen in support of this request. Dennis Senibaldi seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

TRAFFIC MIRROR REQUEST – RANGE ROAD AT TURTLE ROCK ROAD

Chief McPherson reported a recent request to install a traffic mirror on Range Road to assist drivers entering Range Road from Turtle Rock Road. Chief Caron indicated that he would need to assess the area to determine what available options may be available to improve driver awareness when leaving Turtle Rock Road.

Chief McPherson made a motion to table the issue until the next Highway Safety Committee meeting to allow time to evaluate the area. Tommy Sharpe seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
