

Windham Cemetery Trustee Meeting

November 10, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 3:10pm. Present were Trustees Bruce Moeckel, Frank Farmer and Barbara Coish and Alternate Wendi Devlin.

Wendi presented each with an updated map of the New Plains Cemetery. We heard several updates from Bruce Moeckel.

1. Bruce talked with Colizzi and Kyle about removing the incorrect base at the Brink lot. He will have Kyle send an invoice so that we may pay half of the cost. Kyle will be removing the incorrect base very soon gratis as he will be there pouring new bases.
2. Bruce can see that there are flags in the ballfield parking lot designating where the new line will go for the pump. Dennis is on vacation so Bruce could not check on the exact timing of the installation.
3. Bruce went to remove the old bunting and saw that it was gone. Wendi had done it.
4. Bruce found trash from an individual in our dumpster. He knows whose trash it is. He will give the person one more chance before addressing the issue with the individual.
5. Everyone agrees that the kiosk is an eyesore and we shall address the removal in the spring.
6. Bruce has volunteered to be the person in charge of raising and lowering flags. Consensus is the as of December first all flags at the cemeteries will be removed for the winter. Taking care of the flags in winter is particularly difficult and actually dangerous to take care of on the Hill in snow.
7. After the first snow storm the chains at the Cemetery on the Hill will be attached to prohibit winter access. Bruce will attend to this.

The Trustees acted upon a waiver request from Anne Stuart (McPhillips) to purchase two lots on the New Plains. Anne is the youngest of six children who grew up in Windham and now lives in Auburn. She wishes to purchase Block 26 lots 18 and 19. Bruce moved; Frank second. Vote 3-0 affirmative. Wendi would have voted yes if she was seated. Anne Stuart will be notified as to the waiver being granted.

The meeting minutes of 10/15/2025 were approved as written. Frank moved; Bruce, second. Vote affirmative 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 3:55pm.
