Call for Volunteers for the Windham NH Route 111 Corridor Study

The Town of Windham is looking for volunteers to participate in a Project Advisory Committee (PAC) for the upcoming NH Route 111 Corridor Study. The study will begin as early as September 2023 and is anticipated to be completed in mid-2025. Approximately eight PAC meetings will take place during this time period.

The study involves the update and extension of the July 2011 corridor study for NH Route 111 in Windham, from the intersection of Ledge Road/London Bridge Road easterly approximately 1.6 miles to the Wall Street/NH Route 111 intersection. This work will also include extending the traffic analysis only from the intersection with NH Route 128 to the intersection of Wall Street. The objective of the study is to identify priority needs for improving the safety and mobility of all corridor users and to improve access management. The central goal is to achieve an appropriate balance between the needs of motorized and non-motorized users of the corridor.

The PAC has the important task of providing public input to the Study Team and the Town of Windham for the project. The PAC has an advisory role in developing a statement of purpose and needs, developing concepts to address the purpose and needs, and assisting in selecting alternatives to be presented for public consensus for the project design. The PAC's role is to provide constructive feedback to the Study Team on the challenges and issues in the Corridor, aid in assessing the pros and cons of the alternatives, and guidance in interpreting and prioritizing feedback from public and stakeholder meetings.

The Town is looking for volunteers to be on the PAC for the following roles:

- Business representatives (2)
- Bicycle/Pedestrian representative (1)
- Community-at-large representatives (2)
