


# TRANSFER STATION

The Transfer Station is for the personal use of Windham residents only. A valid permit/vehicle decal is required. Permits are free and issued at the Transfer Station.

Use of facilities by contractors is prohibited per the Town of Windham Solid Waste Ordinance.
